HealthONE

This is a firefighter self-enrollment cancer screening program through the primary care physician at their current locations, which are at Centennial and Potomac. HealthONE is working to add their Englewood location by July 2022. Firefighters will be able to use their own health insurance to help pay the cost of the screening as long as their health insurance has a contract with HealthONE. If no contract exists, firefighters will have the option to use self-pay. When the appointment is made by the firefighter, a financial counselor will explain the self-pay option with them.

DetecTogether

This resource can bringing their 3-Steps to early cancer detection program to firefighters. They also offer a free 30-minute training that can be brought directly to fire departments. I've attached their flyer.

Galleri Blood Test

A blood test for cancer screening, is available to any firefighter through most any physician knowledgeable of this test. At this time, health insurance does not cover the \$1,000 cost. The Galleri multi-cancer early detection test detects more than 50 types of cancer, many of which are not commonly screened for today.
